



PRE-DOC ELIGIBILITY

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply to the California Pre-Doctoral Program/Sally Casanova Scholarship:

- Must be either a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident at the time of application.
- Currently enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student at a CSU.
- Must be enrolled in at least one unit or credit during the scholarship year.
- Must have a faculty mentor/sponsor from the applicant's home campus who is available for the duration of the scholarship year.



LET CDIP SUPPORT YOUR DOCTORAL JOURNEY

The California State University (CSU) **Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive Program (CDIP)** offers financial loans to promising doctoral students who intend to apply for future CSU instructional faculty positions. Participants also benefit from mentorship by a CSU faculty member.

CDIP ELIGIBILITY

Students who meet one of the following criteria are eligible to apply to the CDIP:


- New or continuing full-time doctoral students currently enrolled in accredited programs in the U.S.
- Undergraduate and master's level graduate students in the application process to accredited doctoral programs in the U.S.
- Lecturers who are enrolled full-time in a doctoral program.
- Special considerations for students in professional and online doctoral degree programs: Applicants in a professional and/or online doctoral degree program may apply to CDIP only if they plan to pursue a tenure-track instructional faculty position AND their doctoral program's mission explicitly includes preparation and training of future university faculty members.

The **California Pre-Doctoral Program** is designed to increase diversity within the pool of university faculty by supporting the doctoral aspirations of students in the California State University System (CSU). The program awards funds to a limited amount of juniors, seniors and graduate in the CSU system.
